
### Hourly Market – Anatomy of a price spike

1. Coal unit trip

**HRVFILLANCE** 


- 2. Increase in demand
- 3. Gas & hydro units respond to increasing demand
- 4. Large gas unit derate
- 5. Three high priced hours
  - HE15 \$998.90
  - HE16 \$999.00
  - HE17 \$990.37
- 6. Appropriate import behaviour
- Load response to high prices (~150 MW)





# Hourly Market – Price Setters

- Price setting is well distributed and changes over time
- Balancing Pool just another player with modest asset base




# Ancillary Services – Market?

 Concern over sustainability




## **Outages & Derates**


- Positive correlation between unplanned outages and forecast demand (2002)
- Behavior differs by owner
- Large turnarounds tending to follow low 30RAPP
- 2001 value ~ (\$2M)

SURVEILLANCE

2002 value ~ \$5M




Pool Price - 30RAPP Vs Planned Outage (Major Turnarounds), PPA Coal Units


## **BC Tie Line -** Economic Flow






### BC + Sask Ties - Market Share

- Market shares affected by transmission access




Market Share of Exporters
