EVENT DETAILS

On August 9, 2018 for hour ending (HE) 08 the VVW2 asset was contracted to provide 10 MW of supplemental reserve. At approximately 07:21 the available capability (AC) of the VVW2 asset was restated to 0 MW following a unit trip. For the duration of HE 08 the AC remained at 0 MW. However, there was no restatement of the supplemental reserve, and VVW2 was not able to meet the supplemental reserve requirements as set out in the ISO Rules. Subsection 3 of section 205.3 of the ISO Rules states;

3(4) A pool participant that submits an offer must, as soon as reasonably practicable, submit a restatement to represent the operating state of the pool asset if:

- the pool asset is no longer able to deliver the MW set out in the offer; or
- the pool participant is not able to meet the requirements set out in Section 205.4 of the ISO rules, Regulating Reserve Technical Requirements and Performance Standards, Section 205.5 of the ISO rules, Spinning Reserve Technical Requirements and Performance Standards or Section 205.6 of the ISO rules, Supplemental Reserve Technical Requirements and Performance Standards, as applicable.

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO rule 205.3.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

- AESO available capability, dispatch and ancillary services offer data for VVW2 for August 9, 2018.
- AESO information request issued to ATCO Power Canada Ltd. dated December 13, 2018.
- ATCO Power Canada Ltd.'s response to the AESO information request dated January 18, 2019.
- Referral from the AESO to the MSA dated March 8, 2019.

DELIVERY OF PAYMENT

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.


