

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### **EVENTS REFERRED TO MSA**


#### MSA sanctions to date per ISO Rules compliance





### **EVENTS REFERRED TO MSA**

### **MSA** handling of suspected contraventions





### ISO RULE 6.6

- 6.6 accounting for less than half of suspected contraventions in recent months
- Suspected 6.6 contraventions pursued by MSA a result of 'human' factors not machine related



### **RESTATEMENT RULES**

- Represent an increasing proportion of suspected breaches
- Generally, an Acceptable Operational Reason req for restatement within the T-2 window
- Restatements with an absent or cryptic reason entered are subject to being flagged
- Participants should review practices around ISO rules 3.5.3.2 and 3.5.5.2



### **AUC RULE 019 AMENDMENTS**

- Amended rule applies to contraventions since Jul 1/08; prior Rule 019 applies to earlier events
- Penalty matrix re-cast per specific rules with clearly defined penalties
- s. 6(2) effectively re-sets non-compliance history
- Until June 30/09 no publication of 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> contravention unless disputed



### **CONCLUSION**

- We continue to work closely with AESO compliance monitoring in this process
- Process designed to be fair and efficient
- The goal is improved compliance not penalties

### INCREASED FOCUS ON FORWARD MARKET MONITORING

- •The forward market is an important part of the electricity market
- •The forward market activities may impact the spot market
- •Better understanding the forward market will enhance the understanding of the overall market




### FORWARD MARKET DATA

- •Amended Electric Utilities Act included in the definition of market participant (EUA Sec. 1(1)):
  - any broker, brokerage or forward exchange that trades or facilitates the trading of electricity, electric energy, electricity services or ancillary services
- •MSA now receiving regular data from exchanges and brokers (regardless of the market share)
- •MSA not proposing to collect data on bilateral trades on a regular basis









### **VOLUMETRIC TRENDS**












### **COMPETITION Number of RRO Sites Switched**






## **ELECTRICITY COMPETITION Market Share (Sites) - Residential Customers**

# NATURAL GAS COMPETITION Market Share (Sites) - Small Volume Customers





### **DUAL FUEL**


% of Competitive Electricity Sites Subscribing to Dual Fuel contracts

#### **SETTLEMENT**


- Pre-Final Error Correction (PFEC)
  - Corrections made before final settlement
- Post Final Adjustment Mechanism (PFAM)
  - Corrections made after final settlement
- Defined in both System Settlement Code and Natural Gas System Settlement Code
  - Currently no data recorded for Natural Gas
