### EVENT DETAILS

From 19:31 to 21:55, on January 15, 2016, WEY1 was generating an average of approximately 23 MW due to an operational deviation while its available capability (AC) and energy dispatch was 35 MW. The AC for the asset was restated to 30 MW at 21:55. ISO rule 203.4 indicates that if an operational deviation extends for twenty minutes or longer, the pool participant must submit an available capability or MW restatement for the asset that represents the operational capability of the asset no longer than twenty minutes after the start of the operational deviation.

### FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO Rule 203.4.

### MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

1. AESO generation, dispatch, and available capability data for WEY1 for January 15, 2016.
2. AESO information request issued to Weyerhaeuser Company Ltd. dated April 12, 2016.
3. Weyerhaeuser Company Ltd.'s response to the AESO information request dated April 24, 2016.
4. Referral from the AESO to the MSA dated April 26, 2016.
5. Information from Weyerhaeuser Company Ltd. to the MSA dated April 28, 2016.

### NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
