EVENT DETAILS

On July 26, 2017 at approximately 15:52, the generating asset AFG1 was dispatched to provide 22 MW of energy. At approximately 16:02, AFG1's output was within its energy dispatch volume plus or minus its allowable dispatch variance, and therefore entered generating asset steady state at minute ending (ME) 16:11. For the 10 minute clock period ME 16:11 to ME 16:20, the average MW delivered by AFG1 was approximately 2 MW (15 MW less than its allowable dispatch variance). Subsection 3(1) of section 203.4 of the ISO rules states:

A pool participant must not, during generating asset steady state, vary the average MW it delivers from a generating source asset in any 10 minute clock period from the dispatch MW by more than the allowable dispatch variance.

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO rule 203.4.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

- 1. AESO generation and dispatch data for AFG1 for July 26, 2017.
- 2. Self-report submitted by Alberta Pacific Forest Industries to the MSA dated August 16, 2017.

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
