EVENT DETAILS				

On June 7, 2017 at approximately 20:41, the CMH1 generating asset received an advanced energy dispatch to move from its current dispatch level of 153 MW to 113 MW effective at 21:00. CMH1 did not move towards the MW level indicated in the dispatch within ten minutes of the time specified in the dispatch. Subsection 4(1) of section 203.4 of the ISO rules states:

A pool participant must move the output of a generating source asset which is:

(a) the subject of a dispatch; and

(b) ramping

towards the MW level indicated in that dispatch within ten (10) minutes of the time specified in the dispatch but not prior to the time specified in the dispatch.

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO rule 203.4.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

1. AESO generation, dispatch and available capability data for CMH1 for June 7, 2017.

- 2. AESO information request issued to the City of Medicine Hat dated October 5, 2017.
- 3. The City of Medicine Hat's response to the AESO information request dated October 12, 2017.
- 4. Referral from the AESO to the MSA dated November 8, 2017.

NOTICE

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
