EVENT DETAILS

At approximately 23:43 on September 7, 2017, the IOR1 generating asset received and accepted an energy dispatch for 141 MW effective at 00:00 on September 8, 2017. By approximately 00:00 on September 8, 2017, IOR1 reached the MW specified in the energy dispatch minus its allowable dispatch variance and reached generating asset steady state. IOR1 remained dispatched for 141 MW of energy through to the first half of HE 23; however, between approximately 09:48 and 22:32 on September 8, 2017, IOR1 varied its generation by more than its energy dispatch minus its allowable dispatch variance. At approximately 22:33 on September 8, 2017, IOR1 restated its available capability value for HE 23 from 141 MW to 5 MW. IOR1 received and accepted an energy dispatch at approximately 22:33 for 5 MW with immediate effect. Section 203.4 of the ISO rules states:

3(1) A pool participant must not, during generating asset steady state, vary the average MW it delivers from a generating source asset in any 10 minute clock period from the dispatch MW by more than the allowable dispatch variance.

[...]

5(3) A pool participant must, if an operational deviation extends for twenty (20) minutes or longer, submit an available capability restatement or MW restatement for the generating source asset that represents the operational capability of the generating source asset and must do so no later than twenty (20) minutes after the commencement of the operational deviation.

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO rule 203.4.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

1. AESO available capability, dispatch and generation data for IOR1 for September 8, 2017.
2. AESO information request issued to Imperial Oil Limited dated November 8, 2017.
3. Imperial Oil Limited's response to the AESO information request dated November 21, 2017.
4. Referral form the AESO to the MSA dated December 19, 2017.
5. Additional information provided by Imperial Oil Limited to the MSA dated January 15, 2018.

DELIVERY OF PAYMENT

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
