EVENT DETAILS

On March 28, 2018 Suncor Energy Inc. submitted planned outage information regarding two units associated with its SCR1 generating asset, STG1 and STG2. STG1 and STG2 were each scheduled to be on outage for portions of April and May 2018. Information available to the MSA indicates that Suncor Energy Inc. had planned these outages in advance of March 28, 2018, and therefore had not submitted the outage information to the ISO as soon as reasonably practical. Subsection 3 of section 306.5 of the ISO rules states, in part:

- (2) A pool participant must, by the first (1st) day of every month after the date of energization, submit the information set out in subsection 3(1) to the ISO related to planned outages that, as of the time of the submission, are planned to occur at any time within the next twenty-four (24) months.
- (3) A pool participant must, with respect to:
 - (a) any revisions to the information submitted to the ISO under subsection 3(1); or
 - (a) [sic] a planned outage that is not included in the submission set out in subsection 3(2);
- submit such information or planned outage as soon as reasonably practical. [...]

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO rule 306.5.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

- 1. AESO available capability data for SCR1 for April 1 to May 13, 2018.
- 2. Self-report submitted by Suncor Energy Inc. to the MSA dated April 26, 2018.
- Additional information provided by Suncor Energy Inc. to the MSA dated May 29, 2018 in response to a MSA communication dated May 23, 2018.

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
