EVENT DETAILS

On June 14, 2019, during each of the HE 08 through HE 23 settlement intervals, a discrepancy of approximately 50 MW occurred between the declared available capability of the import asset ESBC and the associated e-tag import volumes. Subsection 6 of section 203.6 of the ISO rules states in part:

- 6(3) A pool participant must submit one (1) or more e-tags for an energy interchange transaction such that the final total amount in MW agrees with the available capability of the single source asset:
- (a) as stated two (2) hours prior to the start of the settlement interval; or
 - (b) as may be restated in accordance with the provisions of this section 203.6, but in any event the final total amount in MW must not exceed the available capability of the single source asset as stated at two (2) hours prior to the start of the settlement interval.

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of ISO rule 203.6.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

1. E-tag data and AESO import offer data for ESBC for June 14, 2019.
2. Self-report submitted by TransCanada Energy Sales Ltd. to the MSA dated July 11, 2019.

DELIVERY OF PAYMENT

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
