EVENT DETAILS

On November 11, 2019, during a period spanning the HE 11 through HE 13 settlement intervals, the DOWG asset varied the average MW it delivered from its dispatch by more than its allowable dispatch variance, for several 10 minute clock periods. Section 203.4 of the ISO rules states in part:

3(1) A pool participant must not, during generating asset steady state, vary the average MW it delivers from a generating source asset in any 10 minute clock period from the dispatch MW by more than the allowable dispatch variance.

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of section 203.4 of the ISO rules

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

- 1. AESO available capability, dispatch, generation and offer data for DOWG for November 11, 2019.
- 2. Self-report submitted by Dow Chemical Canada ULC to the MSA dated December 6, 2019.

NOTICE
