EVENT DETAILS

On September 1, 2021, at approximately 17:38, the WST1 asset varied outside of its allowable dispatch variance due to an operational deviation. Information available to the MSA indicates that no restatement was made within 20 minutes. Section 203.4 of the ISO rules states, in part:

5(3) A pool participant must, if an operational deviation extends for twenty (20) minutes or longer, submit an available capability restatement or MW restatement for the generating source asset that represents the operational capability of the generating source asset and must do so no later than twenty (20) minutes after the commencement of the operational deviation.

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of section 203.4 of the ISO rules.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

1. AESO available capability, dispatch, generation and offer data for WST1 for September 1, 2021.
2. AESO information request issued to DAPP Power L.P., dated February 1, 2022.
3. DAPP Power L.P.'s response to the AESO information request, dated February 15, 2022.
4. Referral from the AESO to the MSA, dated March 14, 2022.

DELIVERY OF PAYMENT

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
