EVENT DETAILS

On May 30, 2022, at approximately 16:37, information available to the MSA indicates that the MEG1 asset went offline due to a forced outage. Information available to the MSA indicates that MEG Energy Corp. did not submit forced outage information in accordance with ISO Rule Section 306.5 as soon as reasonably practicable.

Section 306.5 of the ISO rules states, in part:

- 5 A pool participant must, as soon as reasonably practicable, submit automatic forced outage information as follows:
- through contacting the ISO by telephone, on a telephone number that the ISO designates, which must contain a voice recording system; and
 - submit a designation of the automatic forced outage as "Derate-Forced" or "Outage-Forced".

FINDINGS

Based upon the information obtained by the MSA, the MSA is satisfied that the event was a contravention of section 306.5 of the ISO rules.

MATERIAL FACTS

The material facts relied upon by the MSA include the following:

- AESO available capability, dispatch, generation and offer data for MEG1 for May 30, 2022.
- AESO information request issued to MEG Energy Corp., dated January 12, 2023.
- MEG Energy Corp.'s response to the AESO information request, dated January 25, 2023.
- Referral from the AESO to the MSA dated February 1, 2023.

DELIVERY OF PAYMENT

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5(1) of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
