MSA FINDINGS			
As of the beginning of the hour ending ('HE') 24, ERV9 had an active offer of 20 MW of fast-frequency response ('FFR'). At approximately 23:42 on December 14, 2024, the ERV9 asset received an advanced dispatch for 16 MW of supplemental reserve effective at 00:00, December 15, 2024. Information available to the MSA indicates that ERV9 did not reduce its FFR offer while under dispatch for supplemental reserve until approximately 5:26 on December 15, 2024. Section 205.9 of the ISO rules states, in part: (7) The market participant must not use the capacity it makes available or that is dispatched to provide fast frequency response service to simultaneously provide operating reserves.			
The MSA is satisfied that the conduct was a contravention of section 205.9 of the ISO rules.
