MSA FINDINGS

Section 205.9 of the ISO Rules provides, in part:

(7) The market participant must not use the capacity it makes available or that is dispatched to provide fast frequency response service to simultaneously provide operating reserves.

As of the beginning of the hour ending ("HE") 24 on December 2, 2025, ERV9 maintained an active offer of 20 MW of fast-frequency response ("FFR"). Information available to the Market Surveillance Administrator ("MSA") indicates that ERV9 continued to offer 20 MW of FFR while concurrently accepting dispatches for operating reserves, and continued in doing so until approximately 07:00 on December 4, 2025.

The MSA is satisfied that the conduct was a contravention of section 205.9 of the ISO rules.

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5.1 of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
