MSA FINDINGS

Section 203.4 of the ISO Rules states, in part:

3(1) A pool participant must not, during generating asset steady state, vary the average MW it delivers from a source asset in any 10 minute clock period outside the allowable dispatch variance.

During the Hour Ending ('HE') 11 on December 8th, 2025, the JFS1 was in generating asset steady state. At 10:46 AM, the JFS1 asset received a dispatch to 0 MW effective for 10:48 AM. Information available to the MSA indicates that JFS1 generated above its allowable dispatch variance (ADV) between 11:21 and 11:54 AM.

The MSA is satisfied that the conduct was a contravention of section 203.4 of the ISO rules.

NOTICE

The Market Surveillance Administrator (MSA) is granted the power and authority under s. 52 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act* to issue a Notice of Specified Penalty where the MSA is satisfied that a person has contravened an ISO rule. Specified penalties are set out in AUC Rule 019.

In accordance with the relevant enactments and rules, a dispute regarding the issuance of a Notice of Specified Penalty or failure to pay the specified penalty in accordance with this notice will result in a hearing or other proceeding before the AUC.

In accordance with s. 5.1 of AUC Rule 019 this Notice of Specified Penalty will be made public no earlier than receipt of confirmation of payment from the Commission and no later than 45 days after issuance. The MSA will, if applicable, also post on its website the link to any decision of the AUC respecting the specified penalty.
