## MSA FINDINGS

Requirement R1 of PRC-004-AB2-1 states:

Each legal owner of a transmission facility, legal owner of a generating unit and legal owner of an aggregated generating facility must analyze misoperations of its protection systems affecting the reliability of the bulk electric system, and develop and implement a corrective action plan to avoid future misoperations of a similar nature.

TA Alberta Hydro LP contravened R1 of PRC-004-AB2-1 as the misoperations of its protection system that occurred at Ghost generating facility on July 21, 2023 were not analyzed, and a correction action plan to avoid future misoperations of a similar nature was not developed and implemented.

The MSA has rejected the Mitigation Plan as no mitigation plan was develop to include a detailed action plan to prevent the occurrence of the contravention of a reliability standard or to correct the contravention of a reliability standard and prevent reoccurrence of the contravention of a reliability standard.

The MSA is satisfied that the conduct was a contravention of Reliability Standard PRC-004-AB2-1, requirement R1. The MSA determined the contravention was Severe based on the fact that the misoperations have not been analyzed.
